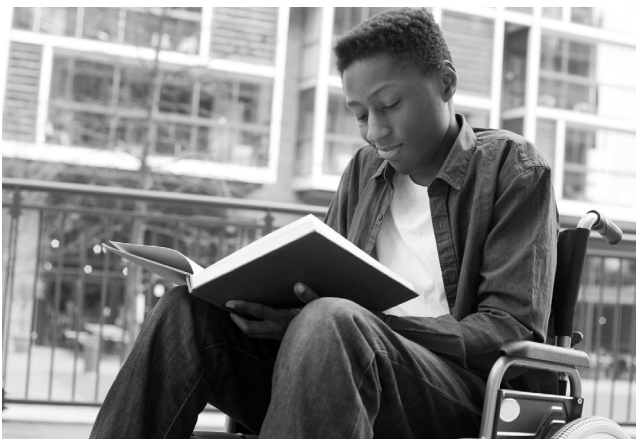
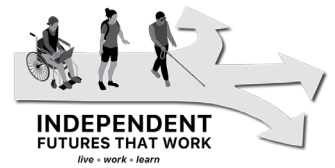


# RSA PTI Independent Futures that Work Project
